Supplies run about \$30-40 a gallon (and they only sell in gallons) – not sure how many colors we would need to purchase yet but CPAE is willing to split costs. Aim is to start with 1 location that is heavily traveled to spread awareness and get some great feedback. The location we are considering is on Rhode Island Avenue just north of the intersection of Calvert Road, right off the bike trail. It is a smaller storm drain estimated to take 5 hours.
