

**Special Session  
College Park City Council  
Tuesday, May 18, 2021

**Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, this was a Virtual Meeting.**

**PRESENT:** Mayor Wojahn; Councilmembers Kabir, Kennedy, Dennis, Esters, Day, Rigg, Mitchell, and Mackie.

**ABSENT:** None.

**ALSO PRESENT:** Bill Gardiner, Interim City Manager; Janeen S. Miller, City Clerk; Suellen Ferguson, City Attorney; Teresa Way-Pezzuti, Director of Human Resources; Terry Schum, Director of Planning.

During the regularly scheduled Worksession on May 18, a motion was made by Councilmember Rigg and seconded by Councilmember Dennis to enter into a Special Session to consider a time sensitive matter. This item was added to the agenda during “Amendments to the Agenda”: Consideration of signing on to Greenbelt’s comments on the MAGLEV Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS). Comments are due on March 23, so this item can’t wait until our next meeting. The motion passed 8-0 and the Special Session began at 9:22 p.m.

**21-G-71 Motion to sign on to Greenbelt’s comments on the draft DEIS statement on MAGLEV project**

Ms. Ferguson said she received Greenbelt’s very lengthy comments this afternoon. Her review indicates that they appear to be consistent with the concerns previously expressed by the City Council about the project: concern about the environmental impacts on Greenbelt and surrounding jurisdictions, and that Prince George’s County is receiving the most impact but doesn’t have a station to receive the benefit.

**A motion was made by Councilmember Rigg and seconded by Councilmember Esters to sign on to Greenbelt’s comments on the MAGLEV DEIS.**

There were no comments from the audience or from the Council.

**The motion passed 8-0.**

**ADJOURN:** A motion to exit the Special Session was made by Councilmember Mitchell and seconded by Councilmember Dennis. The motion passed 8-0 and Special Session ended at 9:24 p.m.
