The Mayor and Council of the City of College Park will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, December 13, 2022 at 7:30 p.m.** to take public comment on the petition request to install a traffic calming device (speed hump) in the 5000 Block of Branchville Road. All interested parties shall have an opportunity to be heard. After the Public Hearing, the Mayor and Council will take action on the request.

Following the receipt of the petition request, the City Engineer's office conducted a traffic study. His report can be found on the City's web site at www.collegeparkmd.gov. Click on "Public Hearing Notice." The report is also available from the City Clerk's office.
