QUALIFICATIONS	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. At the time of taking office (expected to be May 16, 2023), the candidate must be 18 years old.2. Be a citizen of the United States;3. Be a current registered voter in the City; and4. Have been domiciled in the City for at least one year immediately preceding the date of qualification.
PROCEDURE	<p>Submit a petition with the signatures of at least 15 registered voters from each Council District*, and other required forms, by Wednesday, April 5, no later than 4:00 p.m. Petitions and other required forms are available from our website by clicking here.</p> <p>*Important: Political district boundaries have changed. The City made changes to Council Districts since the last City election. District boundaries are adjusted every ten years based on how the population changes. A new Council District map can be found here. Contact the City Clerk to determine the new boundaries by address.</p>
